6. WCD REPORT – SHELLY THIEL

- Shelly thanked site hosts in WCD and the great job they do on providing information and quality events
- A letter from the Bremerton Sun was received from by Shelly regarding the moving of the SK vs Skyline game to Mt. Tahoma. Shelly responded with the rationale for the move.
- An updated list of approved playoff sites was presented with the addition of North Kitsap HS.
- A copy of the Run Down was presented. One major item was the Board approval of an additional \$25 per high school and \$50 per middle level to be billed by the Volleyball Officials Board to offset revenue loss from the new statewide agreement. The Board had originally denied the request, it was appealed to WIAA and returned to the Board for action. It was deemed there were unique circumstances to Volleyball for this year and a one-year change was eventually approved. Schools will be receiving additional invoices from the Association. The Board requested of the WIAA to reopen the contract and negotiate financial hardship language.
- Another item was the lack of swim information being turned in by coaches/AD's to the 3A/2A meet is an ongoing issue. It was suggested to the Board that a fine be levied on teams that do not meet deadlines for WCD Meets. The Board did not take action, but recommended that schools be requested to do a better job.
- Negotiations with Showare Center has been continuing for WCD Basketball Tournaments.
- Amendment for a basketball "mercy rule" will be resubmitted by WCD
- Shelly gave a website update for WCD. Direct link to WIAA in center of the page. Click on forms for updates and expense reimbursement information.
- New certificate coming for winter sports
- Keep ejection reports coming in to Shelly for Coaches
- Boys Swim must submit 11 Dive Meet qualifying meet request to Shelly by December 11th, 2009 to be approved as a qualifying meet for WCD.
- Broadcasters must follow the proper steps through the site and Shelly for payment to get approval for any broadcast.
- Classification process is in full swing and numbers will be out December 1st and be listed from the biggest to the smallest school on the WIAA website.
- It is suggest that schedules not be made for next year until the classification process is completed, especially for football non-league games.
- Thanks for responding to the concessions prices questionnaire.
- Girls Basketball Officials made a request for locker rooms for officials that are appropriate and private.
- Discussion on the Challenge/Glue Rule was held.
