**Philosophy / General Agreements:**

- 1) The goal of district tournament play is to send the best teams / individuals to the state tournaments.
- 2) District tournaments are for teams / individuals that, through the course of the regular season, have earned the right to move into post-season play. The number of teams, or individuals, participating in district tournaments should reflect this belief.
- 3) Tournament formats will remain consistent as possible, regardless of state berths.
- 4) If leagues are of equal size, all advantages listed below will be alternated from year to year.
- 5) If leagues are of unequal size, league size will be taken into consideration and advantage given to the league with the most teams, for:
  - a) Home field advantage
    - \* If same seed from leagues, the league with the most teams would be the home team. If not the same seed, the higher seed to be home.
    - Example: Olympic #3 @ Nisqually #3
    - Example: Nisqually #4 @ Olympic #3
  - b) If a "bye" is available in tournament seeding
    - \* If same seed from leagues, the league with the most teams would be given the "bye" in tournament schedule, if available.
  - c) If a "#1" berth must be assigned to state without playing each other
    - \* Olympic League 2008-09; Nisqually League 2009-10
- 6) Leagues will determine their league seeding to district tournaments.

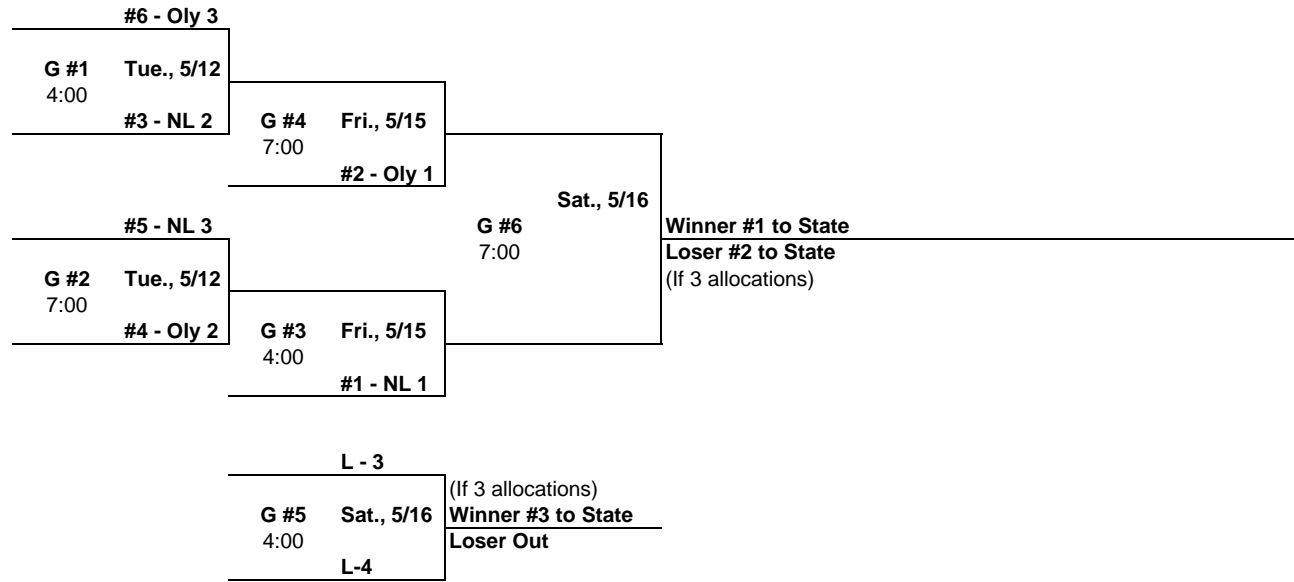

Even number of teams in leagues

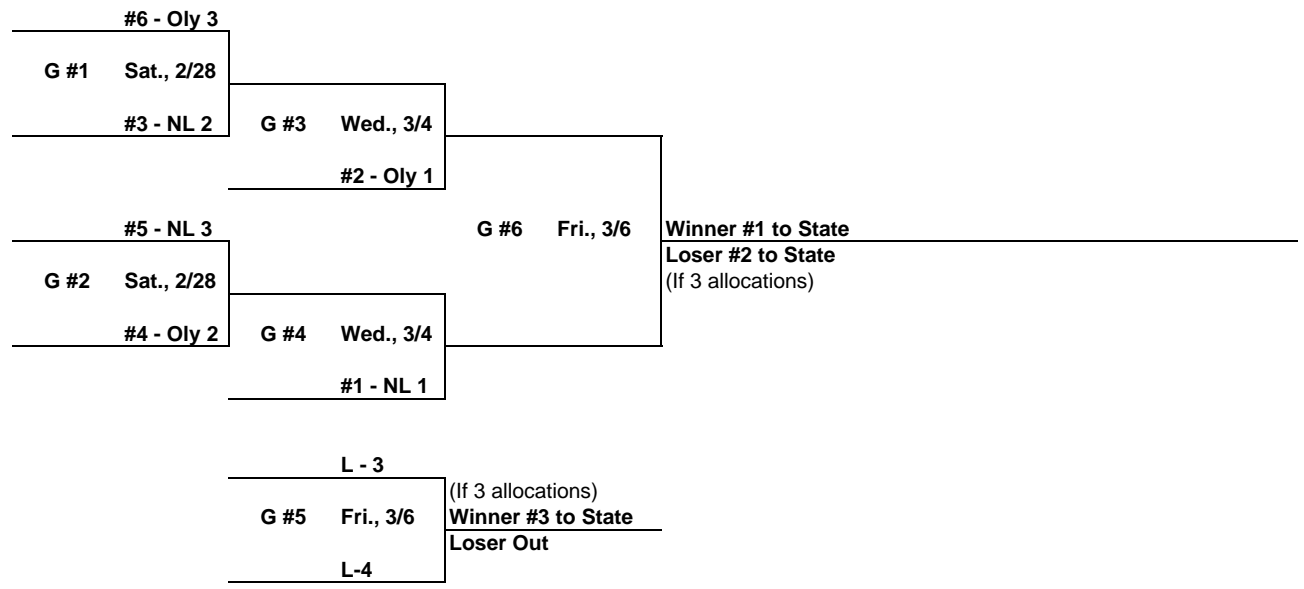

Even number of teams in leagues

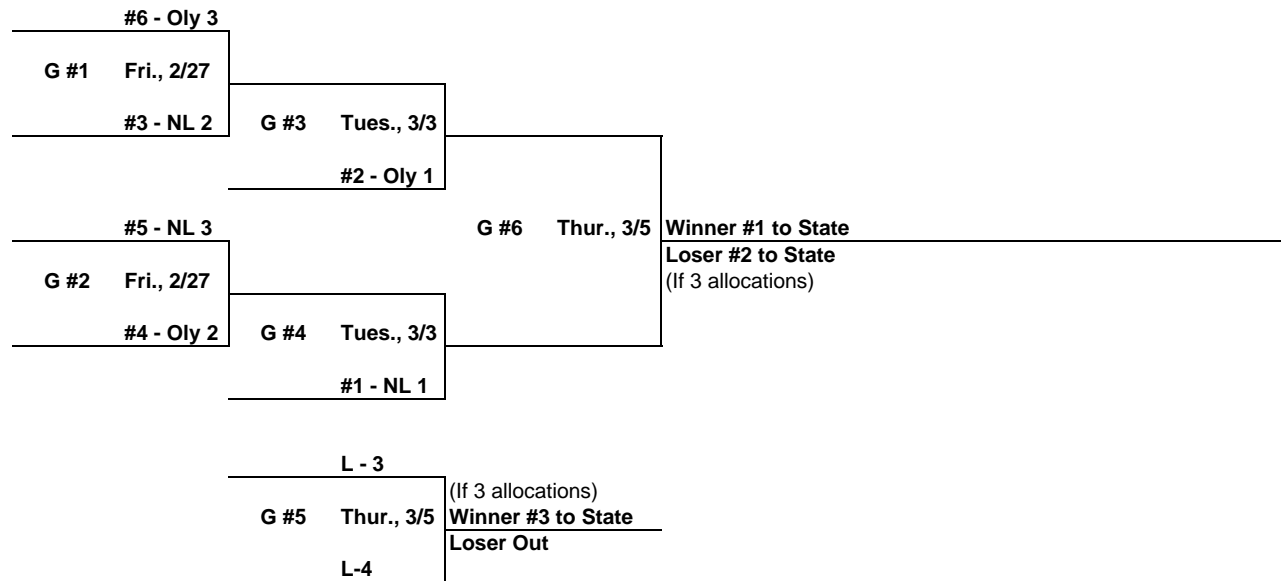

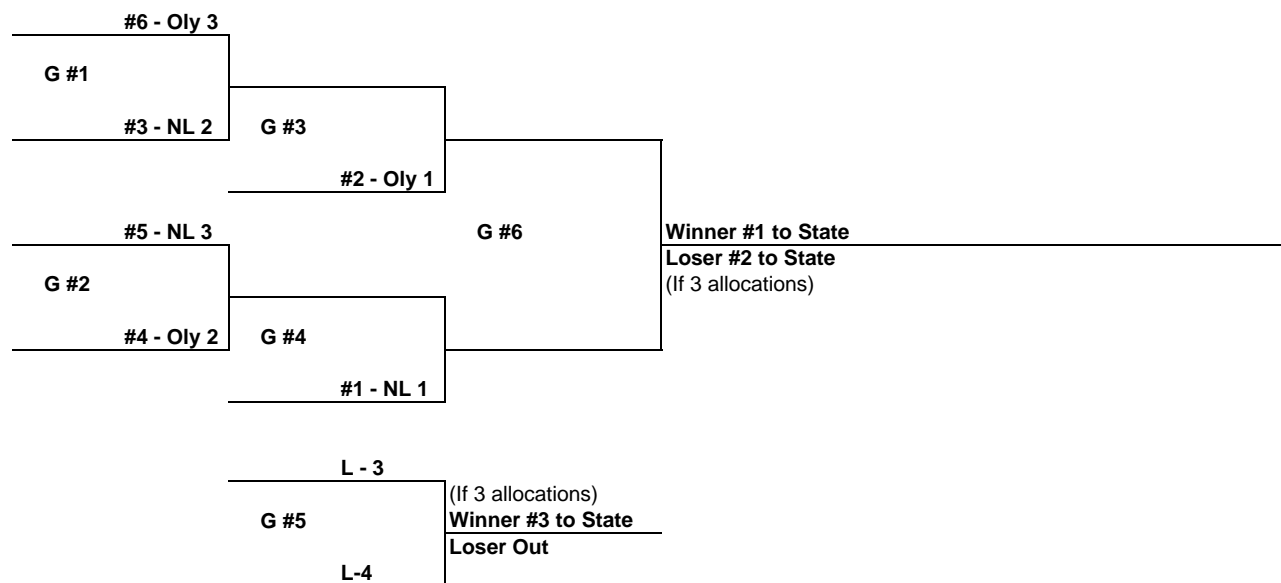

If both #2's, or both #3's win, Oly earns the #1 and NL earns #2

If a #2 and a #3 win, the higher seeded team earns the #1 and the other team earns #2

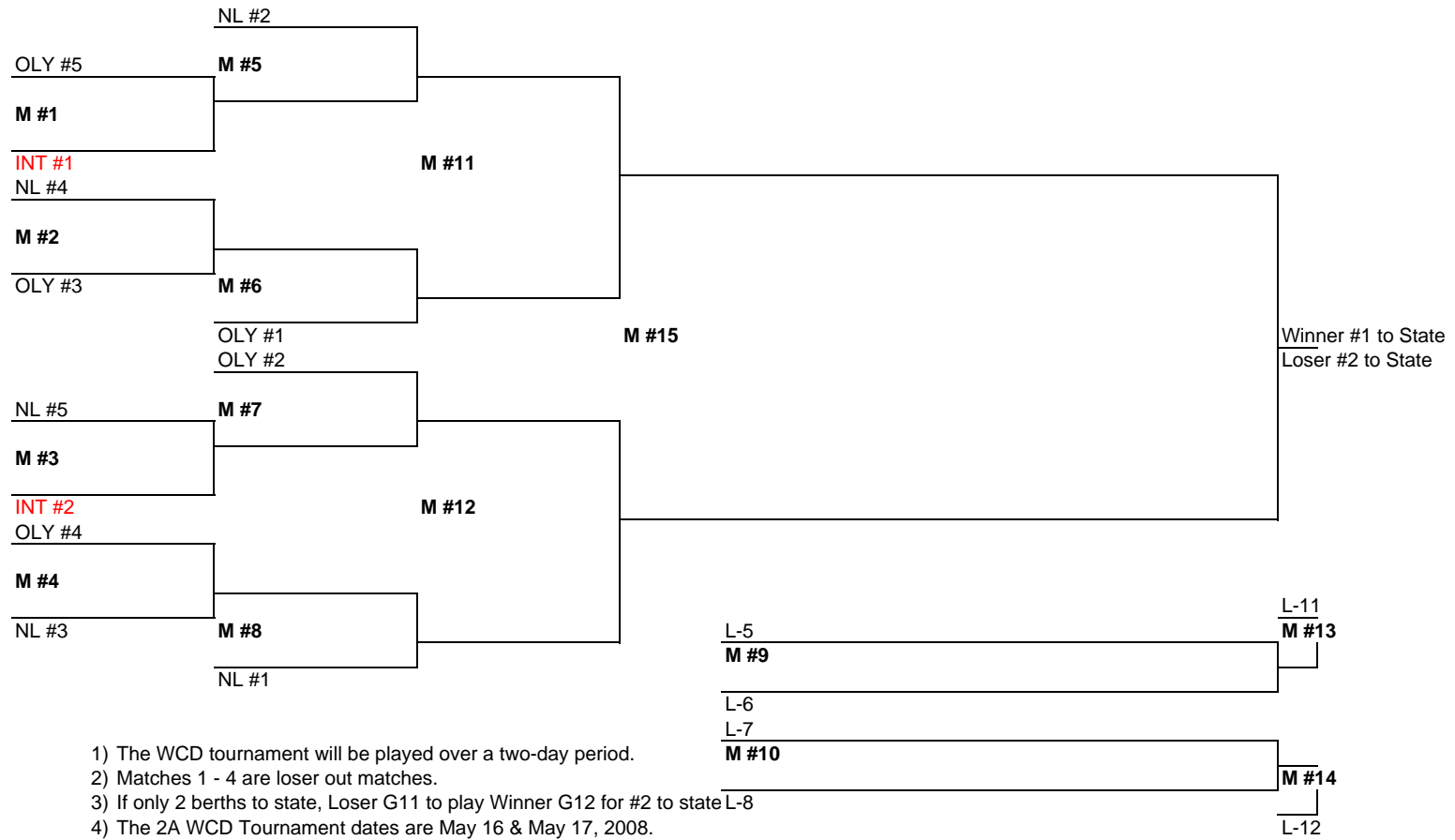

    - \* Prelims on Wednesday, May 20th, for all events except 3200 finals
    - \* Finals on Saturday, May 23rd
  - 3) Allocations:
    - \*Nisqually League will qualify seven (7) athletes per event
    - \*Olympic League will qualify seven (7) athletes per event
    - \* Interlake will qualify two (2) athletes per event**
  - 3) Sub-District results should be submitted to the Track & Field website.
  - 4) Coaches must enter the athletes that qualify on the website.
  - 5) WCD meet will be held on Saturday, May 23, for the 2008-09 season.

**SPORT:                    WRESTLING**

- Wrestling Notes:
- 1) Each league will hold a sub-regional tournament to qualify athletes for Regional Tournament.
  - 2) Interlake will wrestle in the Nisqually League sub-regional in 2008-09 and the Olympic League sub-regional in 2009-10
  - 3) Allocations from 2008 sub-regional meets:
    - \*Nisqually League will qualify four and one-half (4.5) athletes per weight class
    - \*Olympic League will qualify three and one-half (3.5) athletes per class
  - 4) Nisqually League #5 will wrestle the Olympic League #4 in pigtail match prior to regional tournament with the winner earning the final seed (#8) into the regional tournament.

## INTERLAKE QUALIFYING STANDARDS FOR WCD TOURNAMENTS

| <b>Football</b>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Five wins against 2A or higher classification on the season</li><li>* If qualifying, Interlake would compete against the team from the Nisqually / Olympic 2A football league receiving the lowest berth (2008 - 3rd; 2009 - 2nd).</li><li>* Interlake would be the visitor at an approved WCD site on Tuesday, November 11 (2008 season).</li></ul>   |
| <b>Baseball</b><br><b>Basketball</b><br><b>Softball</b><br><b>Volleyball</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Interlake will have the opportunity to earn the #3 (to WCD tournament) berth from either the Nisqually League or the Olympic League.</li><li>* Interlake's season winning percentage against 2A or higher classification will be compared to winning percentage of the #3 with the lowest winning percentage. If Interlakes' winning percentage is better, they will take that spot in the bracket.</li><li>* <b>Nisqually and Olympic league schools' winning percentage will be based upon league games against 2A competition.</b></li><li>* If Interlake has a better winning percentage than both #3's and the winning percentage of #3's is the same, there will be a playoff game between the #3's to determine which team will be eliminated. Interlake would take the loser's spot in the bracket.</li><li>* If Interlake and both #3's all have the same winning percentage, there will be a three-way tie breaker played prior to the WCD tournament to fill the two spots.</li></ul> |
| <b>Soccer</b>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Same as baseball, basketball, softball and volleyball</li><li>* The one difference is that rather than winning percentage, a percentage based upon the possible number of points will be calculated.</li><li>* Points will be three (3) for a win and one (1) for a tie.</li><li>* Interlake's points will be calculated <b>against 2A or higher classification opponents throughout the season.</b></li><li>* Nisqually and Olympic league schools' <b>points</b> will be based upon league games against 2A competition.</li></ul>   |
| <b>X-Country</b>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Interlake will enter a team (7 boys and 7 girls) at the WCD Meet.</li></ul>  |
| <b>Bowling</b>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Interlake does not have bowling</li></ul>  |
| <b>Golf</b>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Interlake will enter a team (5 boys and 5 girls) at the WCD tournament.</li></ul>  |
| <b>Swimming</b>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Interlake will enter all who meet qualifying standards as posted on WCD website.</li></ul>   |
| <b>Tennis</b>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Interlake will enter two (2) boys' singles, two (2) boys' doubles, two (2) girls' singles, and two (2) girls' doubles in WCD tournament.</li></ul>   |
| <b>Track &amp; Field</b>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>* Interlake will enter two (2) athletes in each event at the WCD Prelim's (sub-district meet).</li></ul>   |
