GENERAL INFO

Post Season 3A- Dist.3/4 Allocation Sharing Plan

Reminder: Final Allocations are not determined until after the third week of each season, and are subject to approval of the WIAA Executive Board.

Financial arrangements as follows:

- Basketball -Dist.4 will receive **12.5 %** of net profit.
- Baseball and Soccer- Dist.4 will keep profit/loss for all games played in round one (1) **at** Dist. 4 sites.
- Tennis- Both Districts will share profit/loss.
- Football and Soccer-Games in first two rounds of State bracket will be shared between districts, as per WIAA regs.
- Remaining Sports- Dist. 3 will keep all profit/loss.

Passes **not** accepted (includes Leagues, School Districts, and State Passes).

- Exceptions:
 1. WCD and SW District Board Members
 2. WSCA (Washington State Coaches Association)
 3. School Board Members, Superintendent
 4. Supervisors according to Tournament Guidelines

Admission Prices:

- All Sports/Activities
 - Adults- \$7, Students without ASB
 - Students with ASB & Senior Citizens- \$5
 - Elementary/Children- \$4

Officials scheduled with host site Assigning Officials Secretary (VB, and BB may have “split crews.)

The District Directors or designee and League Contacts will authorize Game/Match/Meet schedule changes.

It is recommended that each sport be represented by a Designated Liaison (in addition to the District Director or designee) for communication purposes.

Soccer and Football games will be played on approved “in- fill all-weather” artificial surfaces.

Roster sizes will be according to State Tournament Guidelines.

Officials will be assigned through the local associations.

Game balls will be assigned according to the Game Manager/Director with approval from the District Directors.

The Dist.3/4Committee may convene within one week after the WIAA Winter and Spring Allocations are established. This will occur if the State Brackets seeding (from the combined Dist.3/4) require adjustments. The District Directors will concur.

This agreement will be reviewed after one year and adjusted if agreed upon by both Districts.
