Game #1 10 am Overlake @ Seattle Christian (Winner to game #3, loser out)

Game #2 1pm Orting @ Meridian (Winner to game #3, loser out)

Game #3 4pm Winner of #1 v. Winner of #2 (Winner to State Regionals @ Anacortes, loser out)

I. ROSTERS

Please complete the enclosed roster sheet/pass list and return it to Seattle Christian High School, via FAX (206) 438-5496 or email: cwrolstad@seattlechristian.org by 3 pm Wednesday, May 13th, 2009.

Each school will be allowed a maximum of **26 people** (18 players in uniform) on the pass list for admittance to the field. This number is to include: **Players, coaches, managers, bus driver, scorekeeper and faculty supervisors.**

II. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- A. Home teams for 1st round games were chosen by a random draw at the Tri-District meetings and will rotate from year to year. The home team for the 4pm game will be determined by a coin flip with the head coaches immediately following the 1pm game. The home team will be in the third base dugout.
- B. Dressing facilities and batting cages will **NOT** be available. Teams are to come dressed.
- C. Each team will have 10 minutes for infield/outfield. The home team will take the field approximately 25 minutes before game time. The visitors will have the field 15 minutes before game time. The field will be cleared for the umpires/managers meeting 5 minutes prior to the game.
- D. Game balls (**Baden 3B-PPro-00**) will be provided by the tournament manager. Teams must furnish their own warm-up balls. Teams should also bring extra game balls to use in emergency cases. **Please assign players to help retrieve all foul balls.**
- E. The official scorekeeper will be provided by the home team.
- F. The 2009 WIAA Baseball State Guidelines will be followed.
- G. The state speed-up rule for tournaments will be used. This includes courtesy runner rules for the pitcher and catcher.
- H. WIAA Tournament rules will apply regarding sportsmanship, signs/banners, noisemakers, confetti and admission.

- I. Game length: All games are **seven (7) innings** and must be played to completion. Any game ending in a tie after (7) innings, will continue until a winner is determined. In case of a game being called after it has begun due to inclement weather, **five (5) innings** will constitute a complete game.
- J. Each team should bring your own towels, in case of rainy conditions.
- K. Supervision – **Each participating school should provide one administrator/designee for crowd control.** Upon arrival, they should introduce themselves to the tournament manager.

III. TICKET INFORMATION

- A. Gates for spectators will open **one hour prior** to the start of the first game. **Please remind your fans that this is part of the Tri-District tournament and it is a paid venue.**
- B. **Prices are set by the Tri-District agreement and will be as follows:**

Senior Citizens	\$5.00

Checks are not accepted. Cash only.

IV. PASSES

The ONLY passes accepted are West Central, Sea-King and Northwest District **Lifetime Passes** and **WSCA (Coaches Association) passes.** **No other passes will be accepted, including league passes.**

V. RAINOUT PROCEDURE

In case of rainouts or rain delays, the host site manager will notify schools. Games will be moved to Monday at a time for rainouts.

VI. PROTESTS

Decisions on protests must be determined at the time of the protest. The tournament committee will act on all tournament protests.

VII. PARKING/ENTRANCE

Directions to Kennedy High School, Burien, WA

Heading North or South on I-5:

Take the Hwy 518 (#154 exit) off of I-5 (W. toward SeaTac Airport). Head W. on Hwy 518 for 4 miles.

When the freeway ends, take a right on 1st Ave. S.

Take a right on 140th St. and then a quick left into the school parking lot.

The field is around the back of the school to the right (just south and above of the track).

Buses should park in the N.W. corner of the school parking lot after dropping off the teams.
