14. Directions to Legion Field, Bremerton
 From Tacoma: Take Highway 16 over the Narrows Bridge toward Bremerton (approximately 30 minutes). Continue on highway through Gorst and follow around the water. You are now on Highway 3. After approximately 2 miles, merge onto Highway 304 toward the Bremerton Ferry and go approximately 1.8 miles. Turn slight right onto Burwell Street / WA 304 (about 1 mile). Turn left onto Warren Avenue / WA 303. Continue to follow WA 303 (about 1.6 miles). Turn right onto Sheridan Road. The field is in sight.
