TEAM ENTRY:

Each team may have a roster of 7 players, 1 scorekeeper and 1 coach. No one other than those listed on the official roster will be allowed on the lower scoring and bowling area.

TYPE OF TOURNAMENT:

First Round is 3 games counting total pins. Second Round will be 4 games Baker Format counting total pins. The total pins after all 7 rounds will determine placement to state. Individuals qualifying for state will bowl in the first 3 games only.

PRE CONTEST WARM-UP:

Fifteen minutes will be allowed for practice prior to the beginning of the tournament and, time permitting, prior to round 2.

TOURNAMENT:

Round 1 Each team will have 5 girls bowl 3 games of total pins. Each team will rotate lanes after each game. At the end of the 3 games teams will change lanes and be paired by total pins. Individuals qualifying for state will bowl in Round 1 only. State qualifying scores can only be obtained while bowling as a member of the 5 girl team.

Round 2 Teams will be paired by results of round 1. 1 with 2, 3 with 4, 5 with 6, etc.. The Baker Format will be used for Round 2. All team members, 5, follow each other in regular order to bowl a single game. Player #1 bowls frames 1 and 6, #2 bowls frames 2 and 7, #3 bowls frames 3 and 8, #4 bowls frames 4 and 9 and, #5 bowls frames 5 and 10. The order of bowling is set by the **coach** and may be adjusted at the conclusion of any game. The combined effort of the team constitutes a game. A pin total after the 4 games of Baker format combined with the Round 1 totals will be used to determine the top 5 4A teams and top 3 2A/3A teams that will qualify for state.

OFFICIAL SCORE:

Coaches shall sign the score sheet game-by-game to accept the score of teams and individuals as official. Coaches or official scorekeeper only allowed in the official scoring area.

TIE PROCEDURE:

Round 1 A coin flip will determine lane placement after Round 1.

Round 2 If two or more teams tie for the last qualifying place for state the teams involved will bowl an additional Baker tiebreak game. This process will continue until one team wins the round.

OPEN SUBSTITUTIONS:

Open substitutions are allowed at any time. If a substitute enters in the middle of a game, the substitute must assume the score of the competitor she is replacing. The score will not be assigned to anyone. The original bowler may not re-enter the game. The same substitution rule applies to Baker Bowling. The tournament manager should be notified of all substitutions prior to the substitute beginning play. WIAA Rule.

TEAM INTRODUCTIONS:

All 7 girls from each team and individuals will be introduced prior to Round 1.

BALL INFORMATION:

- A. The ball may not be removed from the establishment during the competition.
- B. The surface of the ball may not be altered between sessions one and two by the use of abrasives.
- C. The use of approved cleaning agents such as isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol is permissible. Use restricted to outside of the immediate bowling area.
- D. Ball Certification: Coaches are responsible to insure that each of their team member's balls will conform to USBC specifications. Please note that balls will be required to be certified at the state finals.

UNIFORM:

Team competitors shall appear in appropriate matching tops and bottoms for their school's bowling uniform. No hats and no jeans may be worn.

CONDUCT OF COACHES AND PLAYERS:

The team captain and coach shall be the official representatives of their team in all communications with the scorers and the tournament officials. The coach, the 5 bowlers bowling in a round, and the official scorer (if used) are the only persons authorized to be in the lane playing area. Coach or scorekeeper only allowed in the scoring area.

AWARDS

Top 2 teams receive a plaque. Top 3 individuals receive pins and 4th through 10th individuals receive ribbons for each of the two tournaments.

GENERAL STATEMENTS:

The official school banner (made of cloth or vinyl) will be the only sign permitted.

Any artificial noisemakers are prohibited.

Screeching & loud chanting should be at a minimum. **No Cheerleader or student led chants.**
