## **Driving Directions**

### **Sunset Chev Stadium, Sumner High School**

**General:** From the North take Hwy 167 southbound. Take the “Hwy 410, Yakima” exit. On Hwy 410, take the second Sumner exit (“Orting, Valley Ave.”) and turn left at the light. Proceed North on Valley Ave

**Teams** - Just **past** the third light (Main St.) you will see the stadium on the left. Turn left into stadium parking lot. Bus parking will be in the designated area in the east end of the lot. An attendant will meet the bus and direct the driver where to park. Team entry is at the east end of the main grandstand.

**Home Band and Rooter busses** - turn left at the third light on Valley Ave. (Main Street). On your right, just past the stadium, will be in the parking loop in front of the high school, west of the stadium. Turn right into the parking loop and park along the right curb

**Home Fan Entry – (South West Main Entrance)** - Just **past** the third light (Main St.) you will see the stadium on the left. Turn left into stadium parking lot. Park any-where in the lot. Main gate/ ticket booth is on the West end of the main grandstand.

**Visiting Fan Entry – (North West Visitor’s side gate)** – proceed **past** the intersection at the third light on Valley, and proceed **past** the entrance to the stadium. Turn left at the first street past the stadium (Washington Street). Proceeding West on Washington St., turn into the school parking lot on the left just past the baseball field. Park in the lot or on the street outside the lot. The Visiting Fan Entrance is at the far end of the parking lot on your left. This entrance is much more convenient for visiting fans, rather than trying to enter at the main gate and crossing over to the visiting side.

## **Field Surface**

Sunset Chev Stadium playing surface is an artificial turf manufactured by “SprinTurf” and installed in the summer of 2002. “SprinTurf” is an in-fill product similar to “FieldTurf,” but with an all rubber in-fill. Football lines, numbers and hash marks are inlaid in white. No metal tipped cleats allowed. No sunflower seeds allowed on the sidelines.

## **Stadium**

"Sunset Chev" Stadium was remodeled in 2001. It features covered home and visitors grandstands, new home and visitor’s side concessions and restrooms, and a recently added new playing surface. Seating capacity is 2,400 on the home side and 1,000 on the visitor’s side.

### **Administrator Supervision**

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. **Only those individuals identified on the pass list will be allowed in for free admission.** Once on site, the administrator or designee should check in with the Site Playoff Manager.

### **Game Ball**

Teams will furnish their own game balls.

### **Team Benches**

The Home Team (CCHS) bench will be on the south side of the field in front of the main grandstand. The Visiting Team (LHS) bench will be on the north side of the field, in front of the visiting grandstand.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. State WIAA guidelines for participant limits will be observed.

### **Uniforms**

The Home team will wear dark-colored jerseys. The visiting team will wear light-colored jerseys.

### **Shoes**

Most of our players wear molded cleats that they would use on a natural grass field. No metal tipped cleats allowed.

### **Dressing Rooms**

The dressing rooms are located under the stadium.  
Home teams will be in the West dressing room  
Visiting teams will be in the East dressing room

Dressing rooms should be available by 5:30 PM.

### **Medical Services**

EMT service will be located at the game site during the contest. Schools are expected to provide their own athletic training services.

### **Admission**

Ticket Gates will be open by 5:30 PM

**Only those individuals identified on the pass list, carrying a WIAA pass, or WSCA Pass will be allowed in for free admission.** School district, or league passes will not be accepted

### **Band, Cheer Squads and Drill Teams**

Bands, and cheer squads (in their designated respective uniforms) will be allowed in at no charge, along with their designated advisors. Drill teams, who have (prior to the game), requested to perform at halftime, will be allowed in at no charge, along with their designated advisors. Bands are requested to notify the site director in advance to reserve space on their designated seating section.

### **Spectators and Crowd Control**

Spectators will be expected to behave as per the WIAA "Just Play Fair" guidelines. No Full face paint allowed, No body Paint allowed, Shirts must be worn at all times. Only a school banner may be displayed as signage, and crash banners must not contain derogatory language.

### **Pre-game Schedule and Player Introductions:**

**The following state WIAA guidelines will be used:**

**Pre-game procedures. NOTE: The time placed on the clock will be 5 minutes fast to allow for introductions after the clock reads ":00."**

5 minutes on the clock: Captains to center of the field with officials.

4 minutes on the clock: Teams enter the field, line up on their respective sidelines and captains rejoin the team.

3 minutes on the clock: The National Anthem will be played

1 minute on the clock: Players to the bench.

0 minutes on the clock: Announcer introduces all members of both teams. The team lines up on the sideline and when introduced the players run out to the 40-yard line as names are called and face 50-yard line (visiting teams on the East 40, and home teams on the West 40). When introductions are completed, team

members will move forward to shake hands on the 50-yard line and return to sideline.
