

NWFL 1-B Football Playoff Format 2011

Playoff's

Top 4 teams in league go to 1st round of playoffs.

#1 will host #4 playing for the #1 seed to State. Held on Fri/Sat Nov. 11th-12th.

Remember District 1,2,3 only receive 1 seed/allocation to state this 2011 season.

In order for our League to get another allocation we will ask the state for a Glue Game with Dist 4. Glue game means we are challenging district 4 for their #2 seed.

District 4 may request a challenge game between our #1 and their #3 on Fri/Sat Nov. 11th-12th, because we are challenging their #2 with the glue game. If this is the case then the game scheduled between our #1 and #4 would be bumped up to Tuesday Nov. 8th.

The winner of our #1 vs #4 will be District 1,2,3's #1 seed.

NWFL #2 and #3 team will play on Tuesday Nov. 8th.

#2 will host #3 in the hosts district on an artificial turf field.

This game will play for the right to play the glue game vs District 4's #2 team.

District 4 receives 2 seeds/allocations to state this season so the winner of the game below will travel to District 4's #2 seed to play for District 4's second seed/allocation.

The winner of this game will play the Glue game against the #2 team from District 4 for their 2nd seed into state. This game will be played in Dist. 4 on Fri/Sat Nov. 11th-12th.

All playoff games will be played on artificial turf fields.

District 1,2,3's Final League Standing Criteria

***Top 4 teams make playoffs**

***Head to Head breaks 2-way ties.**

3-Way Tie Breaker Formula for 3 teams tied for 1st or 2nd.

If there is a 3-way tie for 1st or 2nd place in league the seeding into the playoffs will be settled by the pre-season draw for numbers that were drawn at the 2010 February league meeting.

This will determine seeding into 1st round of playoffs.

This will alleviate travel costs and unnecessary short week games.
