Why:

The top 38 boys and 41 girls in the 3A classification will qualify for the state tournament.
The top 13 boys and 13 girls in the 2A classification will qualify for the state tournament.
The top 34 boys and 19 girls in the 1A classification will qualify for the state tournament.
Additional players may also qualify if they did not finish within the allocation above and meet the state minimum standard score of strokes above the course rating given below:
3A Boys - .3, 3A Girls – 5.8, 2A Boys – .4, 2A Girls – 6.9,
1A Boys – 2.3, 1A Girls – 12.9

Ties for the final qualifying spot will be contested with a one-hole tiebreaker until the tie is broken. The host professional or tournament manager will establish the hole(s) to be played for the tiebreaker.

When:

Monday, May 17th 3A Girls tee off the “blue” side. 3A Boys tee off the “red” side. All groupings are subject to change as no two players from the same school will play in the same group, if possible. See the tee times for the 3A tournament below.

Tuesday, May 18th 2A Boys tee off the “red” side followed by the 2A Girls. All groupings are subject to change as no two players from the same school will play in the same group, if possible. See the tee times for the 2A tournament below.

Tuesday, May 18th 1A Boys tee off the “red” side followed by the 1A Girls. All groupings are subject to change as no two players from the same school will play in the same group, if possible. See the tee times for the 1A tournament below.

How: The Rules of Play:

Stroke Play

Boys will play from the white tees and girls will play from the gold tees. Eighteen holes of stroke play under the conditions set by the course professional, grounds keepers and the USGA will prevail. All players should be prepared for summer rules to govern the play. Local rules will be explained to the coaches and players prior to tournament play.

Caddies

No personal caddies, motorized carts, electronic aides, or yardage calculators will be permitted. Handicapped players may be granted the use of a motorized cart in accordance with the WIAA state tournament guidelines.

Etiquette

No headphones, **cell phones**, or electronic media may be **in possession of players**. Coaches and spectators may not use cell phone or any electronic media on the course during competition. Swearing, betting, club throwing, or distractive behavior may result in a penalty, disqualification, or removal from the course. Possession of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drugs will result in immediate disqualification. All players are expected protect the field of play by raking traps, replacing divots, repairing ball marks, and keeping pace with the group in front.

Dress (extracted from the WIAA state regulations)

Each player must be wearing appropriate golf attire, including shirts with sleeves and collar. Cut-offs or jeans are illegal. Shoes are required. If a violation occurs, the tournament manager or designee is empowered to disqualify the player.

Greens Fees:

All participating schools must present a check payable to Eagle Pride Golf Course in the amount of \$18.00 per player to Tim Tubbs upon arrival to the golf course. No tee time will be made available without payment. Exact amount of cash will be accepted, but no receipt will be made available other than this document. Tim Tubbs, tournament manager, will sign at your request. Fees are subject to change.

Driving Range:

A token for golf balls will be sold for **\$5** and will provide approximately 50 balls. Range use on Monday, May 17th will be restricted to Monday tee times only. Fees are subject to change.

Lunch:

The lunch room is subject to the discretion of Eagle Pride GC, but snacks will be available beginning at 11:00am; whether or not a full lunch menu will be offered.

Management:

Starters, Marshalls, Scorers, Recorders and the Rules Committee will be provided.

Coaches:

It is required that all players be accompanied by a coach or faculty representative from the school that the player represents. Non-players will be allowed on the course as observers only from a distance greater than 50 feet. All communications will be restricted to between nines or after the final putt by all players in that group with the exception of the one designated boys and girls coach from the school. The designated coach will be permitted to communicate with the respective player(s) after completion of any hole by the entire group and prior to the first tee shot of any player in the group on the subsequent hole. **There will be a coaches meeting 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled tee time.**
