ALLOCATIONS

2A/3A Allocations from the WCD to the State meet: **2 team, 12 individuals, 4 all-arounds.**

Only schools that have qualified to the WCD meet as a team are eligible to qualify for the State meet as a team.

ROTATION / COMPETITORS

See attached for a detailed list of the rotation schedule. Please note that the times are approximate. An awards ceremony will be held after the last rotation. A team consists of six (6) competitors per event, including any all-around competitors, with five (5) scores counting toward the team total and a maximum of twelve (12) competitors per school. Teams will be asked to assist in taking down the equipment while the finals scores are calculated.

WARM-UPS

The gym will open at 8:00 AM for stretching and tumbling on the warm-up equipment and last until 9:00AM. The first warm-up rotation will run from 9:00-9:20AM. March in will be at 9:30AM. After introductions, teams go directly to their events or to the warm-up gym.

The only time the competition equipment will be available for warm-up is during the timed warm-up period, prior to competition. This one-touch warm-up will consist of one (1) vault per gymnast, three (3) minutes per team on bars, one (1) minute per gymnast on floor and thirty (30) seconds per gymnast on beam. (The floor and balance beam will follow the Capital Cup format).

TICKETS AND PASSES

Prices are established by the District III Executive Boards:

Adults & Students w/o ASB:	\$7.00
Jr. & Sr. High students w/ASB, Seniors Citizens:	\$5.00
Elementary students	\$4.00

- Only competing gymnasts in uniform, entering with team prior to their meet, will be admitted free entrance. Gymnasts will be expected to pay if not participating in meet.
- No participant passes will be issued—Inform gymnasts they are to enter in one group with a coach supervising. As per WIAA guidelines, a maximum of sixteen (16) team personnel will be admitted—to include a maximum of twelve (12) gymnasts and four (4) other designated team personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians, medical, etc.). **ONLY COMPETING GYMNASTS WILL BE ALLOWED FREE ENTRY.** Gymnasts and team personnel will be hand-stamped to allow re-entry throughout the meet.
- Press passes will be accepted with proper identification.
- League passes will NOT be accepted.
- Washington State Coaches Association passes will be accepted.
- Cheerleaders and song leaders of participating schools will be admitted free, only if in uniform.

AWARDS

The WCD will provide two team trophies and individual awards for 1st-10th places, and state qualifiers.

CONCESSIONS / HOSPITALITY

Concessions will be available for spectators and gymnasts. There will also be a hospitality room available for coaches, officials, and tournament staff. Each team is expected to bring a food or drink item to share in the hospitality room.

SOUVENIERS

There will be T-shirts available at the meet for athletes and fans to purchase.
