

2010 West Central District 3/SW District 4 3A Boys Soccer Playoffs

1. Ingersoll is a turf field with covered seating for 3,200 it is located next to Olympia High School. The main stadium parking, cars only—**NO buses should enter this parking lot**— is located east of the high school on North Street.
2. **Team buses are to park in the bus lot located off Carloyn Avenue**--Turn into the lot immediately after the baseball field. Team members will enter through the north stadium gate adjacent to the baseball field.
3. A warm-up area is located behind the stadium (grass surface). Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing in the first game will be allowed on the field no earlier than 10:30 AM. During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches for team introductions.
4. Teams will be directed to a dressing room located at the stadium. Access to dressing rooms may not be immediately available upon arrival due to the number participating teams. The locker rooms are located under the main grandstands at Ingersoll Stadium. Home teams will be in the locker room to the Right (north). Visiting teams will be in the locker room to the Left (south). Dressing rooms will be open at 10:00 AM for game #1. For games and #3, dressing rooms will be available directly after halftime of the previous game. Please take your valuables and bags out of the locker room at the end of halftime to the bench area.
5. The stadium will open for spectators at 10 am. All spectators should enter through the south gate located off the North Street parking lot.
6. Drink containers, cans, bottles, etc. may not be brought into the stadium and all bags are subject to search.
7. We do not allow seeds, gum or sugar-based drinks on the track or field surface.
8. To establish an effective communication network with our game managers and security personnel. Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. **Please complete the attached pass list form and bring a copy to the stadium on game day. Only those supervisors, whose names appear on the pass list, will be allowed free entry.** Once on site the supervisor should check in with the Site Playoff Manager.
9. Please have local media contact my office no later than Wednesday, May 12th, if they are planning to attend. There is limited space in the pressbox, however, with prior knowledge arrangements can be made.

Team Benches

Both team benches will be located on the East side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located north of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench will be located south of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field or track. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

Uniforms

The Home Teams will wear light-colored jerseys. The Visiting Teams will wear dark-colored jerseys.

Player Introductions

The Visiting Team roster will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to mid field and form a single line to the west facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the North of mid field. **FOR THE FIRST GAME ONLY**, after the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (north end) for the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.
