At Silverdale Stadium

If NL #1 and Oly #1 both win, NL #1 earns state #2 seed.

If Oly #1 and NL #1 both win, Oly #1 will earn state #1 seed.

If only one #1 wins, they will earn state #1 seed; winner of #2's will earn #2 berth; and other winner #3.

If both #3's win; winner of #2's is #1 seed, Oly #3 is #2 seed, and NL #3 is #3 seed.

Field Surface:

Silverdale Stadium playing surface is an artificial turf manufactured by "Sprint Turf" and was installed in the summer of 2004. Soccer lines are inlaid in yellow. **No food or seeds allowed, only water is permitted on the field.**

Administrator Supervisor:

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. Please complete the attached pass list form and return by **4:00 PM on Thursday May 14**. Only those supervisors, whose names appear on the pass-list, will be allowed free entry. Once on site, the supervisor should check in with the Site Playoff Manager or Main Ticket Gate.

Game Ball:

Three game balls (3) should be furnished by the Home Team.

Team Benches:

Both team benches will be located on the West side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located north of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench will be located south of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

Uniforms:

The Home Teams will wear light-colored jerseys. The Visiting Teams will wear dark-colored jerseys.

Shoes:

Most of our players wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field.

Locker Rooms, if needed:

The locker rooms are located at/in Olympic High School.

One team will be in the locker room to the left.

One team will be in the locker room to the right.

Dressing/locker rooms will be open at 10:00 AM for game #1. For game #2 and game #3, dressing rooms will be available directly after halftime of the previous game. Teams should plan to carry their bags to and from the field during their games. **Leave no valuables in the locker rooms.**

Pre-game Schedule:

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing in the first game will be allowed on the field no earlier than 10:30 AM. During the warm up period, referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period, (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

Player Introductions:

The starting line up for the Visiting Team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to midfield and form a single line to the South (ticket gate side of midfield) facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the North of midfield (scoreboard side of midfield). **FOR THE FIRST GAME ONLY**, after the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (north end) for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion, teams should return to their respective benches.

Medical Services:

A certified athletic trainer should be on site responding to needs of athletes before, during and after the games. Fire and rescue has been notified of the upcoming games.

Admission (set by the WCD Board):

No checks accepted – cash only.

Ticket Gates will open at 10:00 AM.

No league supervision passes will be accepted.

Spectators and Crowd Control:
