Directions:

From I-5 North: take Exit 125, Bridgeport Way/McChord A.F.B exit. Turn Right off of ramp onto Bridgeport. Go .6 miles to 112th. Turn left on 112th. Go .5 miles and the stadium is on the right.

From I-5 South: take Exit 125, Bridgeport Way/McChord A.F.B exit. Take left and go over freeway. Go .6 miles to 112th. Turn left on 112th. Go .5 miles and the stadium is on the right.

Field Surface:

Harry Lang Stadium playing surface is synthetic grass by "Field Turf." PLEASE NO SUNFLOWER SEEDS OR ANY DRINKS OTHER THAN WATER ON THE FIELD SURFACE. NO FOOD ALLOWED ON THE FIELD SURFACE.

Administrator Supervision

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. Please contact the Site Playoff Manager with the name of the supervisor prior to game day. Once on site the supervisor should check in with the Site Playoff Manager.

Game Ball

Three game balls (3) should be furnished by the Home Team

Team Benches

Both team benches will be located on the North side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located west of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench will be located east of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

Uniforms

The Home Team will wear light-colored jerseys. The Visiting Team will wear dark-colored jerseys.

Shoes

Most players prefer to wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field.

Dressing Rooms

The locker rooms are located at the stadium behind both grandstands.

Home teams will be in the South locker room

Visiting teams will be in the North locker room

Locker rooms will be open one hour prior to the first game of the day, then directly after halftime of the preceding game. Teams should plan to carry their bags to and from the field during their games.

Pre-game Schedule

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing in the first game will be allowed on the field no earlier than 45 minutes before the start of the game.

During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

Player Introductions

The starting line up for the Visiting Team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to mid field and form a single line to the east (toward the concessions) facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the west of mid field.

FOR THE FIRST GAME ONLY, after the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (west end) for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

Medical Services

A certified athletic trainer will be on site responding to needs of athletes before, during and after the games.
