Administrator Supervision

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. **Please complete the attached pass list form and bring a copy to the stadium on game day. Only those supervisors, whose names appear on the pass list, will be allowed free entry.** Once on site the supervisor should check in with the Site Playoff Manager.

Game Ball

Three game balls (3) should be furnished by the Home Team

Team Benches

Both team benches will be located on the North side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located west of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench will be located east of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field or track. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

Uniforms

The Home Teams will wear light-colored jerseys. The Visiting Teams will wear dark-colored jerseys.

Locker Rooms

The locker rooms are located under the main grandstands at Memorial Stadium. Home teams will be in the locker room to the left. Visiting teams will be in the locker room to the right. Dressing rooms will be open at 10:00 AM for game #1. For games #2

and #3, dressing rooms will be available directly after halftime of the previous game. Please take your valuables and bags out of the locker room at the end of halftime to the bench area.

Pre-game Schedule

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing in the first game will be allowed on the field no earlier than 10:30 AM. During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches for team introductions.

Player Introductions

The Visiting Team roster will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to mid field and form a single line to the East (scoreboard side of mid field) facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the West of mid field. **FOR THE FIRST GAME ONLY**, after the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (west end) for the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.
