1. PARKING

Visiting team buses will enter Highline Memorial Field from South 156th Street, which is South of the field, and park in front of the cafeteria.

The address is 420 South 156th Street Burien, WA 98148

2. ACCESS TO FIELD

Gates will be opened 1-1/2 hours before game time. Special request for earlier admittance will be honored by calling (206) 433- 2323 or stubbl@comcast.net

3. LOCKER ROOMS

A. Located beneath main grandstand.

B. Locker room security is the responsibility of the respective schools.

C. Showers are not in use at this time.

D. Please pick up paper, tape, etc. and put in garbage receptacles provided.

E. Sunflower seeds are not allowed in the locker rooms or on playing field.

4. FLAG CEREMONY

Teams will be in the center of the field after introductions and for the flag ceremony approximately **five minutes** before game time.

5. COACHES AND PLAYERS ONLY - WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE FIELD

All others, including student photographers, players not in uniform, sports reporters, or coaches' children are restricted unless given permission.

6. WARM UPS. Warm-up sessions on the track are not allowed.

7. SCOUTING/PRESS BOX

Football Only: Five press box passes will be issued to the head coach at Highline Stadium prior to the game.

8. SUNFLOWER SEEDS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN MEMORIAL STADIUM

9. TICKET SALES

All home and visitor admission tickets will be purchased at the southeast corner of the Stadium which is adjacent to the Moshier Field parking lot. Home and visiting schools are Requested to have sufficient supervision for students.

10. SUPERVISION

Scott Stubberfield will be responsible for the overall stadium/field operation during games.

Each school needs to be represented by at least one person. **NO** cross-field traffic will be permitted during football games or at half-time. The school supervisors need to identify themselves at the gate.

11. RESTROOMS AND CONCESSIONS

Restroom facilities for visiting fans are located in the entry building on the southeast corner of the field and on either side of the grandstands. A large concession stand is adjacent to the south grandstand.
