From I-5: take WA-512 (Exit 127 east) toward PUYALLUP / Take the MERIDIAN ST S exit. / Turn LEFT onto S MERIDIAN / Turn LEFT onto 7th Ave SW / End at **601 7th Ave SW**, Puyallup, WA 98371-6816, US

From Hwy 167 South: take WA-512 West toward PUYALLUP & OLYMPIA / Take the MERIDIAN ST S exit. / Turn RIGHT onto S MERIDIAN / Turn LEFT onto 7th Ave SW / End at **601 7th Ave SW**, Puyallup, WA 98371-6816, US

PARKING

The actual paved stadium parking lot on the south side of Sparks can accommodate 120 cars. There is curbside parking on surrounding streets.

STADIUM RE-ENTRY

Students leaving the stadium will not be allowed to re-enter. Adults will be stamped for in/out.

SUPERVISION PASSES

Participating schools will receive **(4) STAFF/ADMIN PASSES, (5) SCHOOL BOARD, (1) SUPERINTENDENT, (1) CHEER ADVISOR, (1) Press, (1) Photo, (1) Video** pass list entries (see form on page 5). Administrators and staff personnel who are expected to help supervise their school's students.

E-MAIL OR FAX THE ENCLOSED FORM OF PASS LIST NAMES TO THE GAME MANAGER NO LATER THAN TUESDAY NOON. SUPERVISORS ENTER THROUGH THE MAIN TICKET GATE ON THE SOUTH SIDE SIDE OF STADIUM.

Band Director and band members **IN UNIFORM** will be admitted free. Home and Visiting School bands -- please park band bus in **SW TEAM Parking Area** and enter the South grandstands from that point.

Cheerleaders **IN UNIFORM** will be admitted free.

There will be no halftime show. Therefore, Dance/Drill team members must purchase a ticket

PASSES ACCEPTED: WSCA, WCD 3, WSSAAA.
NO OTHER SEASON PASSES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

CONCESSIONS

The concession stands will be operated by the **Puyallup School District** and are located behind the south grandstands.

PRESS / TV / RADIO PASSES

HALF TIME ENTERTAINMENT

Halftime is 10 minutes. There will be **NO HALF TIME** field shows, i.e., Band, Drill, or Cheer.

SEATING

WIAA tournament regulations state that a section of seating **must be available** for students who wish to stand for prolonged periods.(WIAA State Tournament Packet. PG. 6, Item M)

Home school (**PUYALLUP HS**) will sit in the **EAST** half of the South grandstands (**see page 6 of this packet**). **Student seating** will be in the section immediately EAST (and adjacent) to the center section of the South grandstand. **WARNING: Viewing the game from the Student Section may be obstructed due to prolonged standing.**

Visiting School (**SKYLINE HS**) will sit in **WEST** half of the South grandstands (**see page 6 of this packet**). **Student seating** will be in the section immediately **West** (and adjacent) to the center section of the South grandstand. **WARNING: Viewing the game from the Student Section may be obstructed due to prolonged standing.**

BAND SEATING

The home team band shall share the home school student section
The visiting team band shall share the visiting school student section

PARTICIPATION/TEAM PASSES

Visiting team, coaches, and personnel will be admitted through the **SW Pass Gate** and park their bus in the **SW Team Parking Area** – (please make arrangements to enter as a team at the same time). The home team coaches will ALSO park in the **SW Team Parking Area** and be admitted through the **SW Pass gate**

TEAM ROSTERS

LIMIT: 22 players
6 Support personal (coaches, managers, statistician, medical)

The number of people on the sidelines is limited to: team members in uniform, coaches, and managers, ball boy/girl, team physician or trainer. The only coaches permitted to be on the sidelines during a state playoff contest shall be limited to the coaches who have been named as soccer coaches by the school district for the regular season. All other persons without sideline authorization from game manager will be escorted to grandstand.

SIDELINES & TEAM BENCH

Both team benches will be placed on the **SAME** sideline (North side of the stadium) and on the TRACK Surface. All Fans are restricted to the **South Grandstand**. Benches are separated by 10 yards and off the turf. A Fourth (4th) Registered Soccer Official is placed at a table between the benches to assist in Substitution and Bench Control.

Home team (**PUYALLUP HS**) will warm up on the East end of the field and occupy the **EAST TEAM BENCH**.

Visiting Team (**SKYLINE HS**) will warm up on the West end (Scoreboard) of the field and occupy the **WEST TEAM BENCH**.

NO SEEDS OR FOOD OF ANY KIND ALLOWED ON THE TURF. SCHOOLS VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL BE BILLED FOR CLEANUP COSTS.

SIGNS & SCHOOL BANNERS

NO signs other than the **OFFICIAL SCHOOL BANNER** will be allowed.

GAME PROGRAMS

The Puyallup School District Athletic Department will take responsibility for the production and/or sale of game programs.

BAND & ROOTER BUSES

Home and Visiting School bands -- please park band bus in **SW TEAM Parking Area** and enter the South grandstands from that point.

ALL Rooter Bus students **may be unloaded** at the **SOUTH** ticket gate where tickets will be sold and/or collected. **Rooter Buses** will be parked **FREE of charge** in the Puyallup Stadium Lot immediately adjacent to Sparks Stadium on the south side of the facility.

LOCKER ROOMS

HOME SCHOOL: (**PUYALLUP HS**) will use the South Grandstand locker room.
VISITORS: (**SKYLINE HS**) will use the North Grandstand locker room.

GAME JERSEYS

HOME SCHOOL: (**PUYALLUP HS**) will wear **LIGHT COLORED JERSEYS**
VISITORS: (**SKYLINE HS**) will wear **DARK COLORED JERSEYS**

MEDICAL

There will be one Certified Athletic Trainer from Apple PT – *Josh Waltier PT, SCS, ATC, CSCS* -- available for both teams.

STUDENT CONDUCT

As games are school functions, students are expected to exercise good judgement in their conduct and dress. **UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT IS CAUSE FOR EJECTION FROM THE PREMISES.** Artificial noisemakers, such as air horns, bells, whistles, etc. are prohibited, as is the throwing of confetti, and/or other objects. Megaphones are to be used by the cheer staff only.

It is important that building **administrators** provide game supervision **in the stands** by promoting a safe enjoyable event for everyone. **Please remind students to wear shirts, to observe the stadium policy of no body or face paint, no masks, no bandanas and to observe good sportsmanship. If an issue with one of your students arises we will ask you to address it.**

PRE-GAME WARMUP

The field will be available 60 minutes before the contest (**6:30PM**)

PRE-GAME INTRODUCTIONS

Starting players will be introduced prior to the start of the game. We ask that each team line up along their sideline for introductions. The visiting team starters will be introduced first, followed by the home team starters. After introductions we ask that both teams face the flag located at the West end of the stadium (scoreboard). The National Anthem and/or Pledge will take place after the introduction of the teams.

FLAG CEREMONY / NATIONAL ANTHEM

Flag ceremony will start at approximately **7:27 PM**. The home school (**PUYALLUP HS**) will be responsible for the playing/singing of the national anthem. In the absence of a band/singer the Pledge of Allegiance will be led by the PA Announcer.

TIE GAMES-STATE TOURNAMENT

In all State play-off games the method of breaking ties will be as follows: If a tie exists at the expiration of a regulation game, no more than two (2) 5-minute sudden death overtime periods will be played. If a tie still exists, each team shall take five (5) penalty kicks, all players on the team roster are eligible for the penalty kicks. Team A will take one penalty kick, then Team B, then Team A, etc., until each team has taken five (5) penalty kicks. The kicks shall be taken alternately. If after each team has taken five (5) penalty kicks and the score is still tied, the taking of the penalty kicks shall continue until such time as each team has taken the same number of kicks and one(1) team has scored one (1) goal more than the other. The kicks shall not continue after a team has scored enough goals to win.
