DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From I-5 Southbound: Take I-5 South towards Portland. Take exit 129 (S. 72nd St./S. 84th St.). Get in the far right lane of this exit. The exit will split and the right lane takes you to 72nd St. At the end of the ramp you will turn right and be heading west. S. 72nd street becomes S. 74th street. You will travel approximately 1.5 – 2.0 miles on 74th street. Mount Tahoma Athletic Stadium will be on the left hand side of the street.

From I-5 Northbound: Take I-5 toward Tacoma/Seattle. Take exit 129 (S. 72nd St.). Get in the left lane and turn left at the end of the ramp onto S. 72nd St. S. 72nd street becomes S. 74th street. You will travel approximately 1.5 – 2.0 miles on 74th street. Mount Tahoma Athletic Stadium will be on the left hand side of the street.

SUPERVISORY PASSES

PLAYING SURFACE

The Mount Tahoma Athletic Stadium playing surface is an artificial in-fill surface.

SHOES

Most players wear normal cleats used on a natural grass surface.

TEAM BENCHES

The home bench will be on the north side (closest to 74th street) of the field in front of the home grandstand (sideline closest to Mount Tahoma High School). The visiting bench will be on the south side of the field in front of the home grandstand (closest to the bell tower).

Coaches, players, managers, trainers, as well as cheerleaders will only be allowed on the field during play.

GAME BALL

Game Balls (three total) should be furnished by the home team.

UNIFORMS

The home team will wear light-colored jerseys and the visiting team will wear dark-colored jerseys.

LOCKER ROOMS

The home and visitor grandstands have a locker room available for each team. Locker rooms will be available at 10:00am for the 11:00am game. The 1:00pm and 3:00pm games will have access to the locker rooms after halftime of the previous game. Teams should carry their bags to and from the field during their game.

PRE-GAME SCHEDULE

Pre-game warm-up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing in the 11:00am game will be allowed onto the field no earlier than 10:30am. Equipment inspection and team captain meeting will take place during the warm-up period.

INTRODUCTIONS OF TEAMS

All players will be introduced prior to the start of the game. We ask that each team line up on the sideline for introductions. The visiting team will be introduced first, followed by the home team. The National Anthem will take place after the introduction of the teams in the first game only. We ask that both teams in the first game remain on the sideline and face the flag located at the north end of the stadium.

HALF-TIME

Halftime is 10 minutes. There will be no half time entertainment.

MEDICAL SERVICES

A trainer will be on site responding to the needs of athletes before, during and after the game. Ice will also be available to the teams after each game.
