## Driving Directions

### **Sunset Chev Stadium, Sumner High School**

From the North - I-405 south to Renton, take Hwy 167 southbound. On Hwy 167, go to the "Hwy 410, Yakima" exit. From Hwy 410, take the second Sumner exit ("Orting, Valley Ave.") and turn left at the light (Valley Ave.).

Teams - Just **past** the third light (Main St.) you will see the stadium on the left. Turn left into stadium parking lot. Team entry is at the east end of the main grandstand.

Fans - At the third light (Main St.) turn Left on Main St. and enter the stadium parking lot on your right. Fan entry is at the west end, nearest to the school building.

### **Field Surface**

**Sunset Chev Stadium** playing surface is an artificial turf manufactured by “SprinTurf” and installed in the summer of 2002. “SprinTurf” is an in-fill product similar to “FieldTurf,” but with an all rubber in-fill. Soccer lines are inlaid in yellow.

### **Administrator Supervision**

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. **Please complete the attached pass list form and return by noon on Friday November 14th. Only those supervisors, whose names appear on the pass list, will be allowed free entry.** Once on site the supervisor should check in with the Site Playoff Manager.

### **Game Ball**

Three game balls (3) should be furnished by the Home Team

### **Team Benches**

Both team benches will be located on the North side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located West of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench will be located East of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

### **Uniforms**

The Home Teams will wear light-colored jerseys. The Visiting Teams will wear dark-colored jerseys.

### **Shoes**

Most of our players wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field.

### **Dressing Rooms**

The dressing rooms are located at the stadium.

Home teams will be in the West dressing room

Visiting teams will be in the East dressing room

Dressing rooms will be open at 12:30 PM. Teams should plan to carry their bags to and from the field during their games.

### **Pre-game Schedule**

Teams will be allowed on the field no earlier than 1:15 PM. During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

### **Player Introductions**

The starting line up for the Visiting Team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to mid field and form a single line to the East of midfield, facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the West of mid field. After the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (West end) for the playing of the National Anthem, or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

### **Medical Services**

A certified athletic trainer will be on site responding to needs of athletes before, during and after the games.

**No** league or district supervision passes will be accepted.

### **Spectators and Crowd Control**

Spectators will be expected to behave as per the WIAA "Just Play Fair" guidelines. No Full face paint allowed, No body Paint allowed, Shirts must be worn at all times. Only a school banner may be displayed as signage, and crash banners must not contain derogatory language. No Noise makers are allowed. **PLEASE share with all student, and parent groups!**
