Hwy 167 (either North or South bound) to “Hwy 410, Yakima” exit. Take the second Sumner exit (“Orting, Valley Ave.”) and turn left. Just past the third light you will see the stadium on the left. Turn left into stadium parking lot. Team entry is at the east end of the main grandstand. Fan entry is at the west end, nearest to the school building.

Field Surfaces

Sunset Chev Stadium playing surface is synthetic grass by “SprinTurf.” Soccer lines are marked in yellow.

Administrator Supervision

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. The WCD Pass List form should be submitted to the tournament manager by 6:00 PM on Thursday Nov. 10 (see above). Once on site the supervisors should check in with the Site Playoff Manager.

Game Ball

The home team will provide three match balls

Team Benches

Both team benches will be located on the North side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located west of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench will be located east of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

Uniforms

The Home Team will wear light-colored jerseys. The Visiting Team will wear dark-colored jerseys.

Shoes

Most players prefer to wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field.

Dressing Rooms

The locker rooms are located at the stadium behind and beneath the home grandstand.

Home teams will be in the West locker room

Visiting teams will be in the East locker room

Locker rooms will be open for the first match at 12:00 PM, and for the second match - after halftime of the preceding match.

Pre-game Schedule

Teams for the first match may begin ball touch warm-ups with 40 minutes on the pre-match clock. For the second match a minimum of 15 minutes of warm-up on the field, and a maximum of 20 minutes. Prior to the start of the on-field warm-up, teams may use our adjacent back grass field for ball-touch warm-ups, or non ball-touch warm-up on the track during the completion of the previous game. During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute

remaining in the warm up period (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

Player Introductions

We will use the International “March Out” during the pre-game announcements, with introductions beginning after the players fan out facing the grandstand. After the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (west end) for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

Medical Services

A certified athletic trainer will be on site responding to needs of athletes before, during and after the games.

Spectators and Crowd Control

All WIAA regulations for spectators will be enforced. No face paint, no hand held signs, no crash banners, only a school approved school banner is allowed. Students may stand in the designated student section only. Spectators will need to watch the game from the grandstand seating areas, and may not stand at the rail or track fence to watch the game. Each school will have a designated seating area on the main grandstand, corresponding with the team benches (home - West side, visitor - East side). Team benches will be on the opposite side of the field.
