Directions:

From the south: Take Highway 167 or I-5 North

167: Take Highway 167 northbound until it ends, continue onto Rainier Ave. S., turn right onto airport way, take a slight left onto Logan Ave. N., Renton Memorial Stadium is on the left. Stadium entrance is via the main south lot.

I-5: Take I-5 North, take exit 154 to merge onto I-405 North towards Renton, take exit 2 to merge onto WA-167 toward Renton, continue onto Rainier Ave. S., turn right onto Airport Way S., take a slight left onto Logan Ave. N., Renton Memorial Stadium is on the left. Stadium entrance is via the main south lot.

From the north:

Take I-5 South, merge onto I-405 North towards Renton, take exit 2 to merge onto WA-167 toward Renton, continue onto Rainier Ave. S., Turn right onto Airport Way S., take a slight left onto Logan Ave. N., Renton Memorial Stadium is on the left. Entrance is via the main south lot.

Busses:

Visiting team/cheer busses should report to the west rolling gate and will unload there. Home team/cheer busses should report to the east rolling gate and will unload there. They will then proceed to park in the main south lot. Busses will return to the same location at the end of the game to reload.

Router/non-participant busses should drop their passengers off at the main south entrance gate and proceed to park in the south lot. Passengers can load the bus where parked at the conclusion of the game.

Field Surface:

The Renton Memorial Stadium playing surface is synthetic turf by "Field Turf." **No food (including sunflower seeds and gum) on the field or track please! Also, water only please!**

Spectators and crowd control:

Spectators will be expected to behave as per the WIAA "Just Play Fair" Guidelines. **The visiting team must designate a "head supervisor" and this person's name must be included on the Renton Stadium Pass List form.** Once on site the head supervisor should check in with the Game Manager. This person can pick up a radio and supervisor's pass when they enter at the south gate. **There will be no student re-entry and adults will be allowed to re-enter for emergencies only. Therefore fans should make sure that they have all needed items before they enter the stadium.**

Game Ball

Three game balls (3) should be furnished by the Home Team

Team Benches

Both team benches will be located on the South side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located east of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench will be located west of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

Uniforms

The Home Team will wear light-colored jerseys. The Visiting Team will wear dark-colored jerseys.

Shoes

Most players prefer to wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field. NO metal spikes allowed!

Dressing Rooms

The locker rooms are located under the south grandstand.

Home teams will be in the East locker room

Visiting teams will be in the West locker room

Locker rooms will be open at noon for game one, and directly after halftime of the previous game for game two. Teams should plan to carry their bags to and from the field during their games.

Signs and school banners

No signs other than the official school banner will be allowed

Pre-game Schedule

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing in the first game will be allowed on the field no earlier than 12:15 PM. During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

Player Introductions

The starting line up for the Visiting Team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to mid field and form a single line to the West (scoreboard side of mid field) facing the main grandstand.

They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the west of mid field.

FOR THE FIRST GAME ONLY, after the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the east end of the stadium for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

Medical Services:

We will have a licensed Athletic Trainer serving as the designated medical authority. This person will respond to needs of athletes before, during and after the games.

Spectators and Crowd Control

All WCD/WIAA regulations for spectators will be enforced. Those not following the regulations are subject to removal from the contest.

Clock

The clock operator is the official time. He/she announces "Two Minutes!" and keeps it running, and then announces the countdown of the last ten seconds unless instructed otherwise by the referee.

Tie Games

The method for breaking ties will be as follows:

Two (2) sudden victory five (5) minute overtimes. A coin toss shall be held prior to the first overtime as per NFHS Rules. At the end of the first overtime period, teams shall change ends. If still tied at the end of the second overtime, penalty kicks will decide the outcome. The head referee shall choose the goal at which all of the kicks from the penalty mark shall be taken. Each coach will select five (5) players, including the goalkeeper, on or off the field (except those who may have been disqualified) to take the kicks. A coin toss shall be held with the winning team having choice of kicking first or second. Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow up on the kick. The defending team may change goalkeepers prior to each penalty kick. Following the five (5) kicks, the team scoring on the greatest number of kicks shall be declared the winner. If the score remains tied, each coach shall select five (5) different players than the first five to take kicks in a sudden victory situation.
