### **Administrator Supervision**

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. **Please complete the pass list form on the Girls Soccer website and return via fax or attachment by 4:00 PM on Thursday Nov. 5. Only those supervisors, whose names appear on the pass list, will be allowed free entry.** Once on site the supervisor should check in with the Site Playoff Manager.

### **Game Ball**

Three game balls (3) should be furnished by the Home Team

### **Team Benches**

Both team benches will be located on the North side of the field. The Home Team bench (Oly, SW and Western Cascade) will be located west of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench (SPSL/Seamount) will be located east of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

### **Uniforms**

The Home Teams (Oly, SW and Western Cascade) will wear light-colored jerseys. The Visiting Teams (SPSL/Seamount) will wear dark-colored jerseys.

### **Shoes**

Most of our players wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field.

### **Dressing Rooms**

The dressing rooms are located at North Thurston high School.

SPSL/Seamount teams will be in the girls dressing room

Oly, SW and Western Cascade teams will be in the boys dressing room

Dressing rooms will be open at noon for game #1. For game #2, dressing rooms will be available directly after halftime of the previous game. Teams should plan to carry their bags to and from the field during their games.

Leave no valuables in the locker rooms.

### **Pre-game Schedule**

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing in the first game will be allowed on the field no earlier than 12:30 PM. During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

### **Player Introductions**

The starting line up for the Visiting Team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to mid field and form a single line to the East (scoreboard side of mid field) facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the West of mid field. FOR THE FIRST GAME ONLY, after the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (west end) for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

### **Medical Services**

A certified athletic trainer will be on site responding to needs of athletes before, during and after the games.
