Tickets will be on sale at the stadium starting 60 minutes prior to match time.

PLAYERS GATE

Entrance to the stadium for team members, managers, and coaches will be on the visitor's side located off of 144th st.
See attached map.

COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSION

1. Participating teams in the playoff will be admitted by Roster. Only players, coaches and managers directly involved in the game are to be included on the roster. A copy of the roster is to be into the Game Manager's office prior to the game.
2. Building administrators, athletic director and a maximum of five supervisory personnel from each school will be admitted by pass list with prior approval? This pass list is to be emailed to the game manager along with your roster **on Friday**.
3. Members of the working press, press photographers, and one school publication staff, who wish to cover the playoff, will be admitted free. Please call the Game Manager by 2:00 p.m. on the day prior to the game.

TEAM ROSTERS

1. Team Roster is to be emailed to the Director no later than Friday. This roster is to have the starting line-up indicated.

2. A team roster is to be given to the opposing coach and referee before the start of the contest.

SUPERVISION

1. Participating schools are responsible for the supervision of their students. Please inform your staff, student body, and cheerleaders of the facility regulations that need to be observed. Pay special note to the tobacco and alcohol /drug free regulation.
2. Spectators must stay behind the fenced areas at the stadium. No spectators are allowed on the sidelines or on the east side of the field.

SEATING

1. The south end of the grandstand is for the home team students and the north end for visitors.
2. No spectators will be permitted inside the fenced playing area.

GAME AND STADIUM REGULATIONS

1. Signs and Confetti, Decorations and Noisemakers
 - a. Signs other than the school banner are prohibited from display. Signs may not be posted near the entrance to the stadium.
 - b. Throwing objects or the scattering of paper in the stands, on the fields, and the general stadium and school area is prohibited. A school violating this policy may be assessed a fine for the cost of cleanup.
 - c. Any plans for decorating the seating area must be approved by the Game Manager prior to the game day.
 - d. Power air horns and other synthetic noisemakers are strictly prohibited. Such devices will be impounded and will be returned, upon request, to the owner after the game. Band instruments are not to be used as noisemakers.

2. Announcements

All announcements made over the public address system or the megaphones used by cheerleaders or other school personnel must refer directly to the program in progress. No other announcement will be permitted unless first cleared by the Game Manager.

3. Concessions

There will be no concessions available for this contest.

PRESS

The press must identify themselves with the game management to secure a sideline pass.

SPECIAL PROBLEMS

The Game Manager is empowered to make any decisions deemed necessary that are not specifically covered by these instructions.

OFFICIALS

Officials will be provided by the Washington State Soccer Referees' Association.

SOCCER BALLS

The match soccer ball(s) will be furnished by the home team.

TEAM BENCHES

Only players in uniform, coaches - named as soccer coaches by the school district for the regular season, managers, trainers, statisticians, and team physicians will be allowed at the team bench.

Only water may be used on the track, field and in the bench areas. Any other type of beverage or food is prohibited inside the fenced area.

UNIFORMS

The home team will wear white or light colored uniforms and is the bottom team on the bracket. The visiting team will wear uniforms in the dark color of the school. Teams are responsible to bring both colored jerseys in case there is a conflict.

DRESSING FACILITIES

Teams should come dressed to play. There are dressing facilities at the stadium if necessary and schools must contact the Game Manager the day prior to the game if they wish to use the dressing rooms. No towels will be provided.

WARM-UP

The field will be open for warm-up 60 minutes prior to game time. Teams will have a 15 minute pregame warm-up at the competition unless coaches of both teams mutually agree to shorten the warm-up time.

TEAM BUSES

The team buses are to park in designated area outlined in the attached map.

TIE GAMES--STATE TOURNAMENT

In all State playoff games, the method of breaking ties will be by State OT procedures.
