DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From I-5 Southbound: Take I-5 South towards Portland. Take exit 129 (S. 72nd St./S. 84th St.). Get in the far right lane of this exit. The exit will split and the right lane takes you to 72nd St. At the end of the ramp you will turn right and be heading west. S. 72nd street becomes S. 74th street. You will travel approximately 1.5 – 2.0 miles on 74th street. Mount Tahoma Athletic Stadium will be on the left hand side of the street.

From I-5 Northbound: Take I-5 toward Tacoma/Seattle. Take exit 129 (S. 72nd St.). Get in the left lane and turn left at the end of the ramp onto S. 72nd St. S. 72nd street becomes S. 74th street. You will travel approximately 1.5 – 2.0 miles on 74th street. Mount Tahoma Athletic Stadium will be on the left hand side of the street.

SUPERVISORY PASSES

Supervisors will be placed on a pass list and will be allowed free entry into the game. Please fax or email this information to our office no later than **Thursday, November 12th at 4:00pm.** Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to help with supervision.

If you have school reporters or photographers attending the game, please add these additional names to the supervisory list. We will allow one reporter and one photographer from each school.

PLAYING SURFACE

The Mount Tahoma Athletic Stadium playing surface is an artificial turf. The soccer field is a rubber/sand in-fill mixed surface.

SHOES

Most players wear normal cleats used on a natural grass surface.

TEAM BENCHES

The home bench will be on the north end of the field in front of the home grandstand. The visiting bench will be on the south end of the field in front of the home grandstand.

Coaches, players, managers, trainers, as well as cheerleaders will only be allowed on the field during play.

GAME BALLS AND BALL GIRLS

Game Balls (three total) should be furnished by the home team. The home team is responsible for supplying a ball girl on each side of the field.

UNIFORMS

The home team will wear light-colored jerseys and the visiting team will wear dark-colored jerseys.

LOCKER ROOMS

The home and visitor grandstands have a locker room available for each team. Locker rooms will be available at 2:00pm. Teams should carry their bags to and from the field during their game. **All equipment and bags should be removed from the locker rooms at half-time as we will be hosting a football game later that evening and teams will have access into these locker rooms at 5:00pm.**

PRE-GAME SCHEDULE

Teams will be allowed onto the field no earlier than 2:30pm. Equipment inspection and team captain meeting will take place during the warm-up period.

INTRODUCTIONS OF TEAMS

Teams will be introduced prior to the start of the game. We ask that each team line up on their sideline for introductions. The visiting team will be introduced first, followed by the home team. The National Anthem will take place after the introduction of the teams. We ask that both teams remain on the sideline and face the flag located at the north end of the stadium.
