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WEIGH IN PROCEDURE

Scales will be open at 7:30 am to check weight.

Weigh in –8:00am - Mount Rainier High School Girls Locker Room.

Wrestlers must have photo ID, either a driver’s license or school ID photo.

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PASSES

No league passes will be honored.

Coaches are to complete and fax the included participation list. Support personnel are considered to be coaches, manager/statistician, trainer and photographer (film or video). This list must be faxed or emailed no later than **Wednesday, February 10, 2008. 206.631.7126**

Cheer staff in uniform will be admitted free. Cheer advisors arriving with the cheer squads will be admitted free. Cheer squads will be limited to 4 per mat during all pre final bouts and up to 8 per mat for finals.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the top 4 place finishers. The top four finishers must have warm-up tops and bottoms on for awards and State program photo taken immediately after the final award presentation in each weight class.

REGIONAL QUALIFIERS

Top 4 finishers in each weight division will qualify for the State "Mat Classic XXI" Wrestling Tournament to be held at the Tacoma Dome, February 19 & 20, 2010. The fifth place finisher will be named the alternate for any Region II scratches.

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OFFICIALS

The five officials assigned will be determined by each association recommendation and official availability.

The officials will alternate throughout the entire tournament.

Two officials per mat will be used for the consolation and championship finals.

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MATCHES ENDING IN A DRAW

Federation overtime criteria and sudden victory rules will apply.

PROTESTS

Protests occurring at the tournament will be presented to the tournament director and he will confer with the rules committee provided the correct WIAA protest procedure has been followed. The decision of the committee will be final.

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MEET PROCEDURES

The National Anthem will open the Championship finals.

FLOOR RESTRICTIONS

Only wrestlers, coaches, officials and designated school staff are permitted in the lower main floor area. Coaches and school staff must wear the provided wrist bands to be allowed entrance into the lower gym. All others are restricted to the upstairs viewing area, and the gym lobby.

Weight classes will be called to the staging area during each session. Wrestlers in the weight class called must report immediately to the staging area. A warm up area for wrestlers will be available in the main gym adjacent to the staging area.

After staging and warm-up, wrestlers will be assigned to a mat, introduced over the PA, and sent to the "On Deck" area behind the scorers table.

Only two support staff are allowed mat side during their participant's bout – they may be head coaches, assistant coaches, trainers or managers. **Two** mat side chairs will be provided.

The designated school photographer will be allowed to be in the corner of the mat during their school's matches and then must leave to the bleacher area.

DRESSING ROOMS

Each school will be assigned a dressing room. Signs will be posted on the dressing room door assigned to your school.

While using the dressing rooms, wrestlers will continuously keep the area clean depositing debris in waste cans, not tamper with PE baskets and leave bulletin boards alone.

MEDIA

Only approved media will be given a mat pass and authorized mat side privileges.

One student photographer will be allowed floor privileges. One student reporter will be allowed lower level (not matside) privileges. **Each student seeking this privilege will have to be identified by a letter signed by their school Principal and approved by the Tournament Manager. They will receive a wrist band and must wear it to retain their privileges.**

Final scores and place winners will be e-mailed to the Tacoma News Tribune and the Seattle Times on Saturday evening. Finals sheets will be available for coaches to fax to other local newspapers. If you bring their fax #'s, we'll be happy to fax for you.

SIGNS

As per league and WIAA rule, no signs will be allowed except for the official school banner.

HOSPITALITY

A hospitality room will be provided by the Mount Rainier High School wrestling booster club. Access to the hospitality room will be reserved for the coaches, designated staff and officials.

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TRAINERS/FIRST AID

A qualified trainer will be present as official event medical authority.

SCORING

- First varsity and second varsity wrestlers will score points for their team.
- Team points will be awarded as follows:
 - 16, 12, 9, 7, 5, 3
- Two advancement points will be scored for each match won in the championship bracket and one point for each match won in consolation. If a wrestler receives a bye in a round, advancement points for that round will be awarded if the wrestler wins their next match.
- Two additional points will be scored for each match won by default, DQ, fall or forfeit.
- 1 ½ additional points will be awarded for each match won by a technical fall.
- One additional point will be awarded for each match won by a major decision.
- In the event two wrestlers from the same school meet, pin points will automatically be awarded.

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BUSES/VANS

Buses or Vans may drop athletes in the front of the school but are encouraged to park on the south side of campus by the baseball fields. **Absolutely no buses in the north student parking lot.**
